Already a knitter, but need a little (or a lot of) help?

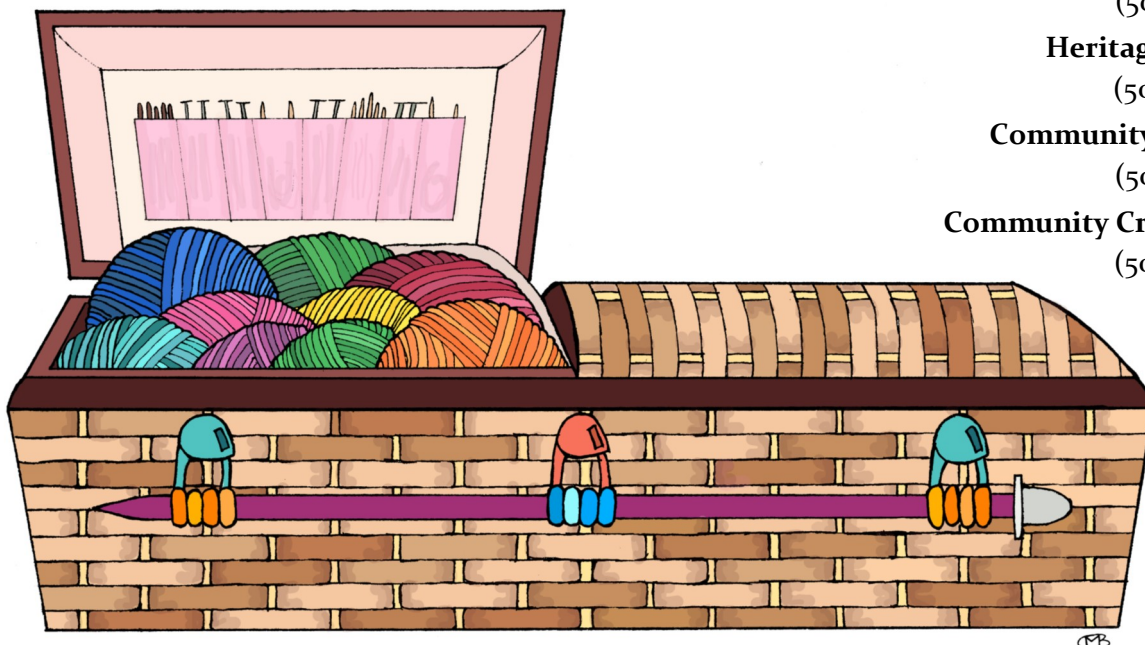
Just want to get out, and make new friends?

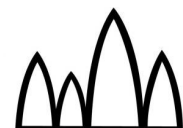
